Description:

THE ORGANIZATION: Art for Global Justice Inc. is a nonprofit organization that promotes arts education as a platform for self-expression. It achieves this through domestic and international youth programs and art exhibits. Tailored to and driven by the specific needs of the communities, Art for Global Justice works to create a global network that encourages solidarity and empowerment through art. Based in New York City, Art for Global Justice has run international programs in Ghana and Guatemala.

THE INTERNSHIP: You will be exposed to the inner workings of a small grassroots organization committed to effective action. Since Art for Global Justice is still a relatively new organization, interns have the unique opportunity to contribute to its growth and scalability. You will be working in a fun environment alongside your peers, doing meaningful work. You will be able to see the direct impact of what you do in this position. The fall intern will work primarily on our “Expressions of la Comunidad” after-school arts program in Washington Heights, on fundraising efforts, and on building our education plans for our Ghana program.

WHO WE ARE LOOKING FOR: We are seeking students with an interest in art, kids, and social justice to join our team for a semester. Interns are expected to work 10 hours per week.

- Have experience working with children
- Be innovative, entrepreneurial and think outside the box
- Be fluent in Spanish
- Be able to travel to Washington Heights on Fridays
